Thus, Vocational Experts are uniquely qualified to provide the highest quality analysis for the Court in family law proceedings involving divorce."

As outlined in the same article, "Divorce may also involve economic loss if one spouse has been out of the labor market, has been partially or totally financial dependent on the other spouse, or is unable to work for various reasons... Without a plan to improve employability and financial self-sufficiency, the spouse may be awarded indefinite maintenance."

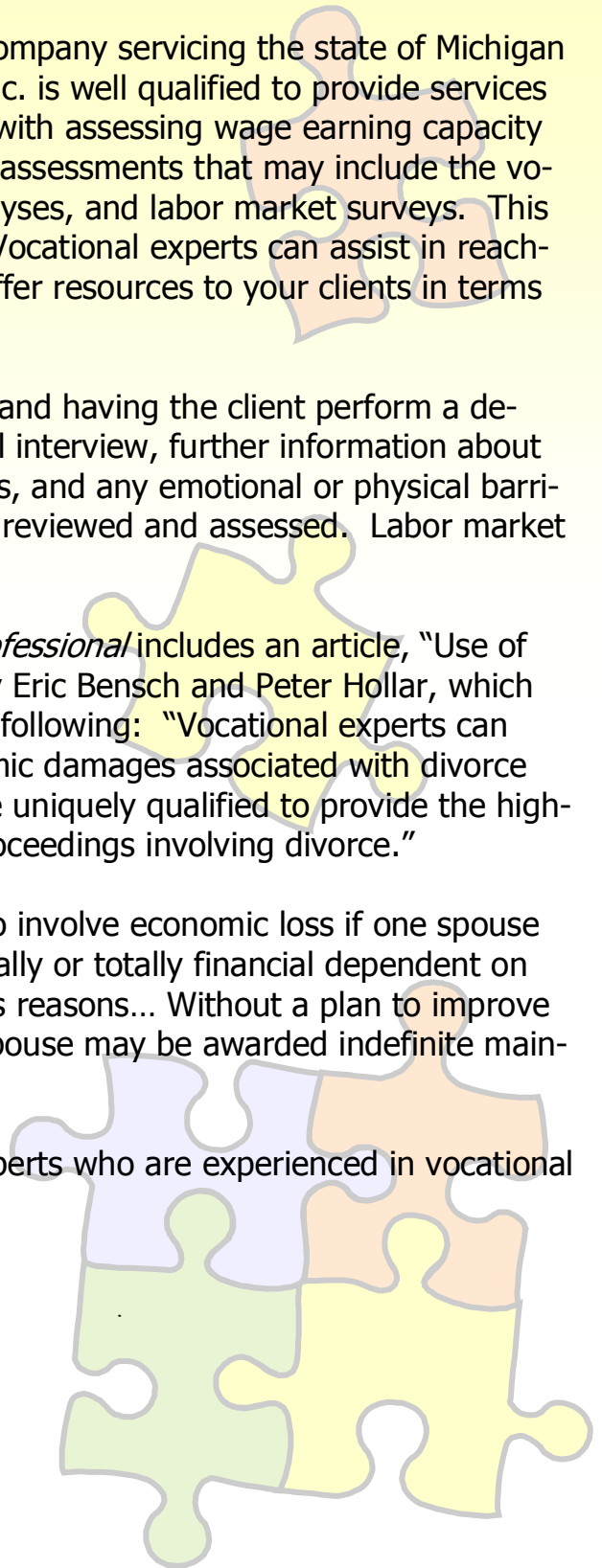

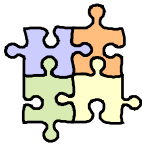
